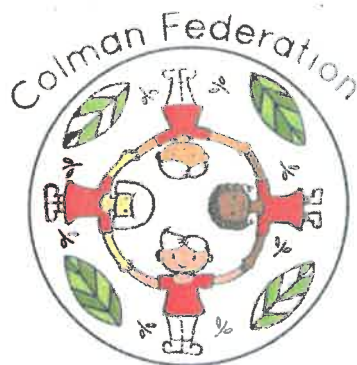

Dear Parent/Carer

Today your child should have brought home their new reading record book. Reading regularly at home has huge benefits for children, it doesn't always have to be their school colour banded reading book, any reading you are able to do will make a difference. You don't need to spend a long time reading with your child unless they want to, 5-10 minutes is great. Please try and write down what you have read with your child in the reading record book at least 3 times a week.

You will also find the Year 1 and 2 common exception words in the reading record. Children should be able to read and write all the Year 1 words and then move onto the Year 2 words. Any support you can give with learning these at home would be very helpful.

Please make sure that your child brings their reading record and reading book to school in their book bag every day. An adult will read with your child at least once a week but this day will change week to week so they always need to bring their book and record into school and then take it home again each day.
