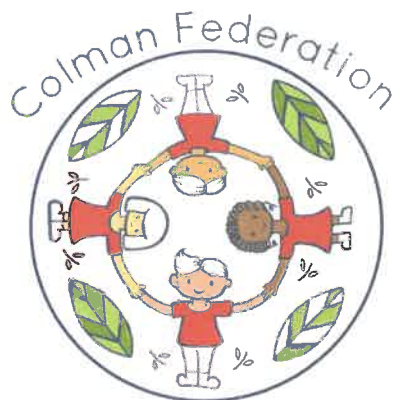

Dear Parents/Carers

**Re: Year 6 Trips to Ringsfield Hall and Pleasurewood Hills**

After 'a year like no other' we are excited to let you know that we have been able to arrange two trips for Year 6 which we hope will give them a memorable end to their time at junior school.

Ringsfield Hall EcoActivity Centre: Monday 28th June

Linking to our topic of Survival, we are going to Ringsfield Hall for a 'Shipwrecked' Day. The children will complete a number of child-led activities including: shelter building, water purifying, cooking on the fire, fire lighting, tinder collection and nettle string making. The coach will be leaving at 8:30am and children will need to arrive on the school site at 8:15am. Children need to be dressed in outdoor clothes which are appropriate for the weather and will need to bring a packed lunch with them. However, if your child is eligible for free school meals a lunch will be provided. We will return back to school around 3:45pm.

Pleasurewood Hills: Monday 5th July

We hope this will be an enjoyable and memorable day for the children after their hard work during a challenging year. The coach will be departing at 9:00am and children will need to arrive on the school site at 8:45am. We will arrive back to school at around 6:00pm. Children will need to wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch, again if your child is eligible for free school meals then a lunch will be provided. They may also bring £5 to spend in the school shop if they wish.

The cost of both trips are £35.00 which include the entry fees and on this occasion the school will meet the cost of the coaches. As both trips take place during school time, the school is only allowed to ask for voluntary contributions from parents/carers. No pupil will be excluded from the visit in the event of a contribution not being forthcoming, however, the school does not have funds to meet the costs, so it will only take place if sufficient voluntary contributions are received. If contributions are not received the trips will have to be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, then the cost of the trips will be met by the school. Payment can be made by ParentPay (which is our preferred option) or by cash or cheque (cheques made payable to "Colman Federation"). Please complete the attached slip (even if you pay via ParentPay) and return to the school office by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> June.
